

FarSite Communications Ltd Declaration on REACH Regulation 1907/2006 and Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs)

Other than as set out below, the delivered product and product packaging, based on FarSite's knowledge and information provided to FarSite by suppliers, do not contain chemical substances included on the initial candidate list¹ in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w).

Exceptions

Cables supplied with the product may contain the following substances on the candidate list:

- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP) (CAS No 85-68-7, EC No 201-622-7)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (CAS No 84-74-2, EC No 201-557-4)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (CAS No 117-81-7, EC No 204-211-0)

FarSite is working with suppliers to confirm whether or not these substances are present in particular cables. This declaration will be updated as soon as any changes occur or new relevant substances are added to the candidate list. Information is currently provided to recipients of FarSite products via the FarSite website at www.farsite.com. This will always contain the most recent published information on REACH and FarSite's products.

FarSite and REACH Compliance

The Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006, commonly referred to as "REACH", is applicable in all 27 EU Member States as well as the EFTA European Economic Area (EEA) countries Norway, Liechtenstein and Iceland. REACH creates a new system for gathering information, assessing risks to human health and the environment, and authorizing or restricting the marketing and use of chemicals produced or supplied in the EEA. REACH has an impact on EEA producers, importers and distributors/retailers of products, and users of chemicals in the course of industrial or professional activities. Requirements are phased and will occur over several years, commencing in 2008. FarSite supports the overall REACH objective of improving the protection of human health and the environment and will meet all applicable REACH requirements. FarSite is strongly committed to working with customers and supply chain to define and implement the REACH requirements and ensure a smooth transition to compliance.
